The People Center Food Pantry



Our food pantry provides a three-day supply of food up to four times per year to area families in need. We receive food and toiletries from private donations, by shopping local sales, and we maintain a seasonal garden to offer fresh produce.

Gently used clothing and housing items to provide families with a new start. This is accomplished through accepting donations from our giving community.

The People Center Transitional Housing



The People Center has a housing program consisting of six transitional apartments where we can house people who face a housing crisis. Our goal is to help families become self-sufficient and be able to obtain and maintain affordable housing.
